- The Built4People partnership brings together the whole value chain to accelerate people-centric innovation for a sustainable built environment.
- Built4People (B4P) is a European co-programmed partnership under Horizon Europe
- Running for 7 years from 2021 2027
- The objectives of the B4P are specified in the Memorandum of Understanding, Link
- Coordinated by ECTP and WGBC

Built4People (B4P) Partnership

A policy cross-cutting initiative, addressing buildings climate-neutrality but also broadly speaking sustainability, reducing resource intensity and increasing recyclability, taking into consideration other policies relevant to buildings, including the need to preserve our European Cultural Heritage.

- Decarbonisation, sustainability and better living (Europe & beyond)
- Gather partners across the built env. value chain for a *cleaner, safer, affordable, smarter, decarbonised & sustainable Built Environment*

B4P Innovation Cluster



A Built4People IC (**B4PIC**): a group of innovation-driven stakeholders, typically formed by one or two local/regional cluster(s), that engage in a maturing process to foster EU-scale, multidisciplinary and sustainable innovation in the Built Environment.

B4PIC Success Factors





Whole Built Environment ecosystem^{*}: integrating as many as possible different stakeholder types from the whole Built Environment innovation value chain (e.g. any entity or organization representing academia, research and industrial innovators, architects and contractors, end users' associations, local authorities, etc.);



Multi-objectives*: targeting several B4P objectives as well as NEB principles;

Cross-sectoral: integrating different industrial sectors, whose members might be transdisciplinary;

Locally anchored with National and European outreach: connecting a local territory with networks at national (national clusters or meta-clusters, e.g., Construction National Technology Platforms) and European (European clusters or meta-clusters) levels;



Cross-border: interconnecting with clusters from other regions or Member States, establishing and promoting interregional activities between two clusters operating in two different local markets or economies;

Access to testbeds and demonstration spaces: integrating or connecting to test beds, pilot buildings, living labs or other facilities to demonstrate innovations and/or facilitate market uptake.

B4PIC Maturity Framework

B4PIC network is composed of the B4PICs that have formally engaged in the B4P maturing process (i.e., signed the B4PIC Charter), assure the exchange of good practices and foster collaboration among B4PICs

Three types of B4PICs

ICs can apply to become B4PICs and benefit from tailored support





- **Prospective B4PIC**: an IC expressed interest and is exploring becoming a B4PIC
- **Emerging B4PIC**: a Prospective B4PIC applied and been accepted (the B4PIC Charter is signed) on the basis of a commitment to progress towards required maturity (not meeting minimum requirements yet)
- Established B4PIC: an Emerging B4PIC has demonstrated it meets the required maturity level in the defined timeline, as agreed in their signed B4PIC Charter

- Communicate the information provided by NEBULA about the funding opportunities for NEB related projects (NEB-specific Calls for proposals from the Horizon Europe programme).
- Identify within their members/network stakeholders with specific needs in financing, upskilling or cooperation for NEB-related projects and share them with NEBULA consortium.
